

TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY WARRANTY DEED

STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA—SWAIN COUNTY

THIS DEED, Made this 29th day of December, 1943, by and between

AARON R. ANTHONY and wife, MARTHA ANTHONY,

of the County of Swain and State of North Carolina, as parties
 of the first part, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA as party of the second part: WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in
 consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX AND NO/100 ----- Dollars (\$1,976.00)
 to them paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do
 grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being
 in Swain County, State of North Carolina, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land lying in Forneys Creek Township of Swain County, State of North Carolina, on the right side
 of the Little Tennessee River, approximately 2 miles northwest of Bushnell, and more particularly described as
 follows:

Beginning at a 36 inch black oak tree at the top of Locust Ridge, a corner of the lands of the Bryson City
 Bank, and Harley Kirkland, and the most northwesterly point of the tract herein described; thence with Harley
 Kirkland's line South 85° 00' East, 1805 feet to a 12 inch pine tree at the top of a ridge, a corner of the
 lands of Harley Kirkland, and Lon C. Kirkland; thence with Lon C. Kirkland's line and the top of the ridge as
 it meanders approximately along a bearing and distance of South 49° 30' East, 410 feet to an oak stump, a corner
 of the lands of Lon C. Kirkland, and Martha Jane Anthony; thence, leaving the ridge and with Martha Jane Anthony's
 line, South 22° 00' West, 280 feet to a stake in the center line of a hollow; thence with the center line of the
 hollow as it meanders approximately along the following bearings and distances: South 42° 00' East, 125 feet,
 South 4° 00' West, 160 feet to a 12 inch buckeye tree; thence, leaving the hollow, South 1° 00' West, 145 feet
 to a fence angle; thence with the fence line along the following bearings and distances: South 7° 00' West, 80
 feet; South 60° 00' West, 155 feet to a 12 inch white oak tree; North 75° 00' West, 225 feet to a 6 inch pine
 tree at a fence angle at the top of a ridge; thence, leaving the fence line and with the top of the ridge as it
 meanders approximately along the following bearings and distances: North 89° 30' West, 230 feet; North 67° 00'
 West, 400 feet; South 87° 30' West, 155 feet; South 62° 00' West, 170 feet; South 85° 00' West, 600 feet to a
 hickory snag; thence, leaving the ridge, South 36° 30' West, 615 feet to a hickory stump, a corner of the lands
 of Martha Jane Anthony, W. W. Crisp, and M. A. Chambers; thence with M. A. Chambers' line North 4° 00' East, 660
 feet to a point, a corner of the lands of M. A. Chambers, and the Bryson City Bank; thence with the Bank's line
 North 5° 00' East, 990 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 52. acres, more or less.

It is understood and agreed that the bearings given in the above description are based on the North Carolina
 State Coordinate System, Lambert Projection, as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey. The central
 meridian for this coordinate system is located at Longitude 79° 00' West.

Being the property acquired by Aaron R. Anthony, one of the parties of the first part herein, by deed
 executed by James N. Anthony recorded in deed book 28 page 188 and by the first parties hereto by deed executed
 by Samuel Anthony and wife by deed recorded in deed book 34 page 255, in the registers office of Swain County N.C.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the UNITED STATES OF
 AMERICA, its successors and assigns, to its own use and behoof forever. And the said parties of the first part, for them selves, their heirs,
 successors, administrators and assigns, covenant with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns that they are seized of said land
 and premises in fee, and have a right to convey the same in fee simple; that the same are free and clear from all encumbrances and that they will
 warrant and defend the title to same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
