

TENNESSEE VALLEY AUTHORITY WARRANTY DEED

THIS DEED, Made this 14 day of February, 1944, by and between

VIRGINIA CALHOUN TIPTON and husband, FILANDER TIPTON, and
ROY R. CALHOUN and wife, BIDDIE DALE CALHOUN

of the County of Swain and State of North Carolina, as parties of the first part, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA as party of the second part: WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX AND 45/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$ 1,526.45) to them paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Swain County, State of North Carolina, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land lying in Forneys Creek Township of Swain County, State of North Carolina, on the right side of the Little Tennessee River, approximately 1 1/2 miles northeast of Calhoun Island, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5 inch spanish oak tree at the top of Chessquaw Ridge, a corner of the lands of the James W. Mitchel Heirs, and T. W. Cable et ux, and the most southerly point of the tract herein described; with T. W. Cable's line N. 52° 00' W., 880 feet to an 8 inch hickory tree; thence N. 10° 30' W., 540 feet to a 12 inch hickory tree at the top of a ridge; thence with the top of a ridge as it meanders approximately along the following bearings and distances: N. 35° 00' E., 390 feet, N. 6° 30' E., 430 feet to an 8 inch spanish oak tree at the top of Pine Ridge, a corner of the lands of T. W. Cable et ux, and the M. T. Calhoun Heirs; thence with the M. T. Calhoun Heirs' line and the top of the ridge as it meanders in a northeasterly direction approximately 2030 feet to a 3 inch white oak tree, a corner of the lands of the M. T. Calhoun Heirs, and W. H. Pilkington; thence with W. H. Pilkington's line and the top of a ridge as it meanders approximately along a bearing and distance of S. 32° 00' E., 540 feet to an 8 inch black oak snag at the top of Chessquaw Ridge, a corner of the lands of W. H. Pilkington, and the James W. Mitchel Heirs; thence with the James W. Mitchel Heirs' line and the top of the ridge as it meanders in a south-westerly direction approximately 3010 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 73. acres, more or less.

It is understood and agreed that this conveyance is made subject to such rights as may be vested in the county or state to rights of way for public roads.

It is further understood and agreed that the bearings given in the above description are based on the North Carolina State Coordinate System, Lambert Projection, as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey. The central meridian for this coordinate system is located at Longitude 79° 00' W.

The above described tract of land was conveyed to Virginia Calhoun, one of the parties of the first part, by deed from C. A. Cable and wife, Flora Cable, dated January 11, 1930, recorded in Deed Book 57, page 86, in the office of the Register of Deeds for Swain County, North Carolina.

The Virginia Calhoun Tipton who is named as one of the parties of the first part is one and the same person as the Virginia Calhoun who is named as grantee in the deed of record in Deed Book 57, page 86, in the office of the Register of Deeds for Swain County, North Carolina.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, to its own use and behoof forever. And the said parties of the first part, for them selves, their heirs, successors, administrators and assigns, covenant with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns that they are seized of said land and premises in fee, and have right to convey the same in fee simple; that the same are free and clear from all encumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the title to same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
