STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA—SWAIN COUNTY

THIS DEED, Made this 31st day of December, 1943, by and between

ARNOLD CABLE and wife, J. J. CABLE,

of the County of Blount and State of Tennessee, as parties of the first part, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA as party of the second part: WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED TEN AND NO/100 Dollars (\$710.00) to them paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Swain County, State of North Carolina, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land lying in Forneys Creek Township of Swain County, State of North Carolina, on the right side of the Little Tennessee River, approximately 1 1/2 miles northwest of the Fontana Dam, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe, a corner of the lands of the H. K. Cable Heirs, and the Carolina Aluminum Company, and the most southeasterly point of the tract herein described; thence with the Company's line North 82° 00' West, 310 feet to a point on the southeast edge of State Highway No. 288, a corner of the lands of the Carolina Aluminum Company, and the J. E. & Bland W. Coburn Heirs; thence with the J. E. & Bland W. Coburn Heirs' line and the edge of the highway as it meanders in a northwesterly direction approximately 400 feet to a point, a corner of the lands of the J. E. & Bland W. Coburn Heirs, and the H. K. Cable Heirs; thence leaving the highway and with the H. K. Cable Heirs' line South 7° 00' West, 240 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 1.2 acres, more or less, subject to such rights as may be vested in the county or state to rights of way for State Highway No. 288, and such rights as may be vested in third parties to telephone and transmission line rights of way.

It is understood and agreed that the bearings given in the above description are based on the North Carolina State Coordinate System, Lambert Projection, as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey. The central meridian for this coordinate system is located at Longitude 79° 00' West.

The above described land was acquired by the parties of the first part by virtue of a deed from Bland W. Coburn and husband, J. E. Coburn, dated September 18, 1934, and recorded in Book 57, Page 584, in the office of the Register of Deeds of Swain County, North Carolina.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, to its own use and behoof forever. And the said parties of the first part, for themselves, their heirs, successors, administrators and assigns, covenant with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns that they are seized of said land and premises in fee, and have right to convey the same in fee simple; that the same are free and clear from all encumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the title to same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
