DECLARATION OF TAKING

Tennessee Valley Authority, the authority empowered by law to acquire in the name of the United States of America the property described in the petition of similar title filed in this Court, hereby files this declaration of taking pursuant to the provisions of an act of Congress approved February 26, 1931, 46 Stat. 1421, c. 307, 40 U.S.C.A. 258a, and declares that said property is hereby taken for the use of the United States of America acting by and through its

corporate creature and agent, the Tennessee Valley Authority, and further declares that:

1. The estate or interest taken in the said property for the said public use is the fee simple title, free of all liens, claims, and encumbrances, except as hereinafter shown.

2. The property taken is described as follows:

Tract FR-566

A tract of land lying in Forneys Creek Township of Swain County, State of North Carolina, on the right side of the Little Tennessee River, approximately 1 3/4 miles northwest of the mouth of Stecoah Creek, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point (previously described as an 18 inch post oak stump), a corner of the lands of the Nantahala Power & Light Company, J. W. Crane et ux, and the Nantahala Power & Light Company; thence with the said Company's line S. 62° 19' E., 675 feet to a point in the center line of State Highway No. 288; thence with the center line of the highway as it meanders in a southwesterly direction and subsequently in a northwesterly direction approximately 800 feet to a point; thence, leaving the highway, N. 10° 00' E., 200 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 2.9 acres, more or less, subject to such rights as may be vested in the county or state to State Highway No. 288 which affects approximately 0.6 acre and to any other rights of way for public roads traversing the described land.

NOTE: The bearings given in the above description are based on the North Carolina State Coordinate System, Lambert Projection, as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey. The central meridian for this coordinate system is located at Longitude 79° 00' W.

Tract FR-730

A tract of land lying in Forneys Creek Township in Swain County, State of North Carolina, on the right side of the Little Tennessee River, approximately 1 1/2 miles northwest of the mouth of Stecoah Creek, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an oak stump, a corner of the lands of the Crisp Heirs, A. J. Posey et ux, and A. J. Posey, and the most easterly point of the tract herein described; thence with A. J. Posey's and the W. H. Calhoun Heirs' line S. 16° 00' W., 898 feet to a point, a corner of the lands of the W. H. Calhoun Heirs, and the J. M. Crisp Heirs; thence with the J. M. Crisp Heirs' line S. 89° 00' W., 264 feet to a point; thence S. 35° 00' W., 520 feet to a stake on the west edge of State Highway No. 288, a corner of the lands of the J. M. Crisp Heirs, and Joseph Collins; thence with Joseph Collins' line S. 78° 00' W., 165 feet, passing a stake at 75 feet, to a point in the center line of State Highway No. 288, a corner of the land of Joseph Collins, and the W. H. Clark Heirs; thence with the W. H. Clark Heirs' line S. 75° 00' W., 80 feet to a 12 inch birch tree at the top of a ridge; thence with the W. H. Clark Heirs', and Lee & Lilly Hering's line and the top of the ridge as it meanders approximately along the following bearings and distances:

N. 16° 00' E., 315 feet; N. 11° 00' W., 435 feet; N. 27° 00' E., 355 feet; N. 28° 00' E., 530 feet; N. 60° 00' E., 235 feet to a chestnut stump, a corner of the lands of Lee & Lilly Hering, and the Crisp Heirs; thence with the Crisp Heirs' line along the top of a ridge S. 72° 00' E., 320 feet to a black gum tree; thence, leaving the top of the ridge, S. 32° 00' E., 215 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 22.3 acres, more or less, subject to such rights as may be vested in the county or state to State Highway No. 288 which affects approximately 0.4 acre and to any other rights of way for public roads traversing the described land.

NOTE: The bearings given in the above description are based on the North Carolina State Coordinate System, Lambert Projection, as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey. The central meridian for this coordinate system is located at Longitude 79° 00' W.

Tract FR-731

A tract of land lying in Forneys Creek Township of Swain County, State of North Carolina, on the right side of the Little Tennessee River, approximately 1 1/4 miles northwest of the mouth of Stecoah Creek, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of State Highway No. 288, a corner of the lands of the W. H. Clark Heirs, and the Nantahala Power & Light Company; thence with the Company's line and the center line of the highway as it meanders in a southerly and subsequently in a westerly direction approximately 3370 feet to a point; thence leaving the highway, S. 62° 19' E., 531 feet to a point (previously described as an iron pipe); thence N. 78° 34' E., 689 feet to a point (previously described as a stake); thence N. 4° 30' E., 331 feet to a point (previously described as a 15 inch

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post oak tree), a corner of the lands of the Nantahala Power & Light Company, Lee Herron et ux, and the W. H. Clark Heirs; thence with the W. H. Clark Heirs' line S. 84° 23' E., 714 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 26.8 acres, more or less, subject to such rights as may be vested in the county or state to State Highway No. 288 which affects approximately 2.3 acres and to any other rights of way for public roads traversing the described land.

NOTE: The bearings given in the above description are based on the North Carolina State Coordinate System, Lambert Projection, as established by the U. S. Coast and Geodetic Survey. The central meridian for this coordinate system is located at Longitude 79° 00' W.

3. One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars and One Cent (\$1,767.01) is the amount estimated by the Tennessee Valley Authority to be just compensation for the property taken. This amount is herewith tendered into Court for the use of the persons entitled thereto. This amount is allotted to the tracts as follows:

4. Tract plats showing the property taken are hereto attached.
5. The authority under which the property is taken is the Tennessee Valley Authority Act of 1933, 48 Stat. 58 as amended, 16 U.S.C.A. sec. 831; the public use for which the property is taken is for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the Tennessee Valley Authority Act.
6. The Board of Directors of the Tennessee Valley Authority is of the opinion that the ultimate award probably will be within any limits prescribed by Congress on the price to be paid.
