THIS DEED, Made this 21st day of December, 1943, by and between TEXAS COLE, guardian of CARO LEE COLE, a minor, of the County of Swain and State of North Carolina, as party of the first part, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA as party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN AND 30/100 Dollars (\$2,587.30) to her paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has bargained and sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its successors and assigns, two certain tracts of land, situate, lying and being in Swain County, State of North Carolina, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
