THIS DEED, Made this 9th day of January, A.D. 1930 by and between
Leonard Conner and wife, Georgia Connor
of Swain County, North Carolina, hereinafter called GRANTORS, whether one or more, and THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA, hereinafter called GRANTEE:

WITNESSETH:

That the said grantors for certain good and valuable considerations moving them thereto, and particularly the sum of FIVE HUNDRED TWO Dollars (\$ 502.00), to them paid by the Grantee the receipt of

which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do hereby bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee, its successors and assigns, the following described lands in Ocona Lufty Township, Swain County, State of North

Carolina, particularly described as follows, viz.: T.R.A.C.T. N.Q. 37

NOTE: All bearings in this description were turned from the true meridian and all distances are expressed in chains of 66 feet.

Lying on the east side of Ocona Lufty River, a short distance below smokemont. BEGINNING at corner 1, which is corner 3 of the "alter Watson Tract (38), a small chestnut with corner marks, and witnesses, on top of a ridge, a 14" spanish oak, blazed and scribed B. T. bears N. 5-00 E. .40 chain distant; thence N. 37-02 E. with the line of George Beck Tract (39), 8.06 chain marked corner 2, which is corner 4 of the Rufus Beck tract (34), a maple marked as a corner, beside a small branch; thence down the branch with its meanders N. 30-45 W. .58 chains; N. 72-06 W. 2.82 chains; S. 52-55 W. 2.78 chains; S. 71-35 W. 3.45 chains, corner 3, a small beadwood, with corner marks at forks of branch; thence with two lines of the Decatur Connor Tract S. 72-15 E. up right fork of branch 3.00 chains, corner 4, a point in branch S. 48-20 W. 17.75 chains, corner 5, a stake on the bank of the public road; thence S. 20-50 E. with the public road 2.16 chains, corner 6, which is corner 5 of the Walter Watson Tract (38), a point in the public road; thence with two lines of the Walter Watson tract N. 47-15 E. 15.70 chains, corner 7 a stake on top of a ridge; thence S. 53-20 E. 1.80 chains, the place of BEGINNING, containing 6.07 acres.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, above described, with every privilege and appurtenance thereunto belonging, to the said grantee, its successors and assigns, to its and their only use and behoof forever.

The grantors covenant to and with the grantee, its successors and assigns: That they are the owners of and are seized of the premises in fee; that they have good right to convey the same in fee simple; that the said premises are free and clear from encumbrances, except as hereinafter stated; and, that they will forever warrant and defend their said title to said premises against the claims of any and all persons whatsoever.
