of _____ County, North Carolina, hereinafter called GRANTORS, whether one or more, and THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA, hereinafter called GRANTEE:

WITNESSETH:

That the said grantors for certain good and valuable considerations moving them thereto, and particularly the sum of Twelve Hundred----- Dollars (\$1200.00), to them paid by the Grantee the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do hereby bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee, its successors and assigns, the following described lands in Swain Township, _____ County, State of North Carolina, particularly described as follows, viz.:

T R & C T N O. 64:
NOTE: All bearing in this discription were turned from the true meridain and all distances are expressed in chains of 66 feet.
Lying on the northwest side of Raven's Fork of Ocona Lufty River, about three-fourth of a mile above its mouth.
BEGINNING at corner 1, which is corner 4 of the Parsons Pulp & Lumber Co. Tract (68), hickory sprout with witnesses, on top of a ridge; thence with seven lines of the Parsons Pulp & Lumber Co. Tract (68) South 15-10 West 1.02 chains, corner 2, a point with witnesses, set a post South 63-23 West 8.92 chains, corner 3, a locust post with witnesses, on a ridge top, a 34" spanish oak, blazed and scribed B.T. -P bears North 56-00 East .16 chain distant; South 41-24 West 1.99 chains, corner 4, a bunch of dead chestnuts with corner marks South 16-17 West 3.21 chains, corner 5, a black gum stump with witnesses, set a post scribed P, a 10" black oak blazed and scribed B.T.P. bears North 75-00 East .07 chain distant; South 9-13 West 4.25 chains, corner 6, a large chestnut, with old marks and witnesses; South 5-52 East 6.63 chains, corner 7, a 12" black oak at corner of fence, a 12" spanish oak, blazed and scribed B.T. -P bears North 45-00 West .25 chain distant; South 13-44 East 11.24 chains, corner 8, which is corner 2 of the W.C. Hollaway Tract (66), a point in the Parsons Pulp & Lumber Co. line; thence South 75-14 West 3.97 chains, corner 9, a stake beside a branch; thence up the branch with its meanders, a line of the Dan Parker tract (65) North 14-52 West 3.09 chains; North 20-40 West 3.52 chains; North 32-27 West 2.61 chains; North 24-39 West 4.87 chains; North 32-17 West 2.73 chains, corner 10, which is corner 8 of the H. N. Conner tract (63), a point on east bank of stream, and beside wire fence, set a post scribed P-S; thence with three lines of the H.N. Conner tract (63) North 45-35 West 1.64 chains, corner 11 a point on bank of road near stream, set a post scribed S-C; North 51-20 East 3.33 chains, corner 12, a point at corner of rail fence set a post scribed C-S; North 16-05 West 10.00 chains, corner 13, a white oak stump on bank of branch, a corner common to the W.C. Caldwell, J. Nations and H.N. Conner tracts; thence North 40-12 East with a line of the W.C. Caldwell Tract (61) 2.90 chains, corner 14, a point on bank of stream, and at corner of garden; thence North 47- 42 East 2.21 chains, corner 15, a point shown by Hillard Enloe as site of old dogwood corner, set a locust post scribed E; thence North 89-22 East 16.49 chains, the place of BEGINNING, containing 25.19 acres. Also all other peices, parcels or lots of land or interest in lands located within the area designated by the Secretary of the Interior as the "Great Smoky Mountains National Park."

The grantors covenant to and with the grantee, its successors and assigns: That they are the owners of and are seized of the premises in fee; that they have good right to convey the same in fee simple; that the said premises are free and clear from encumbrances, except as hereinafter stated; and, that they will forever warrant and defend their said title to said premises against the claims of any and all persons whatsoever.
