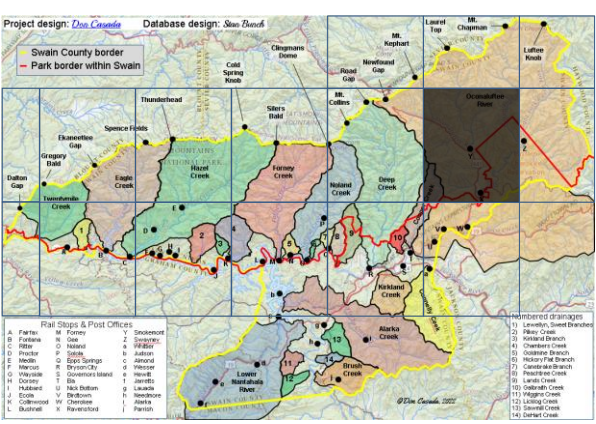
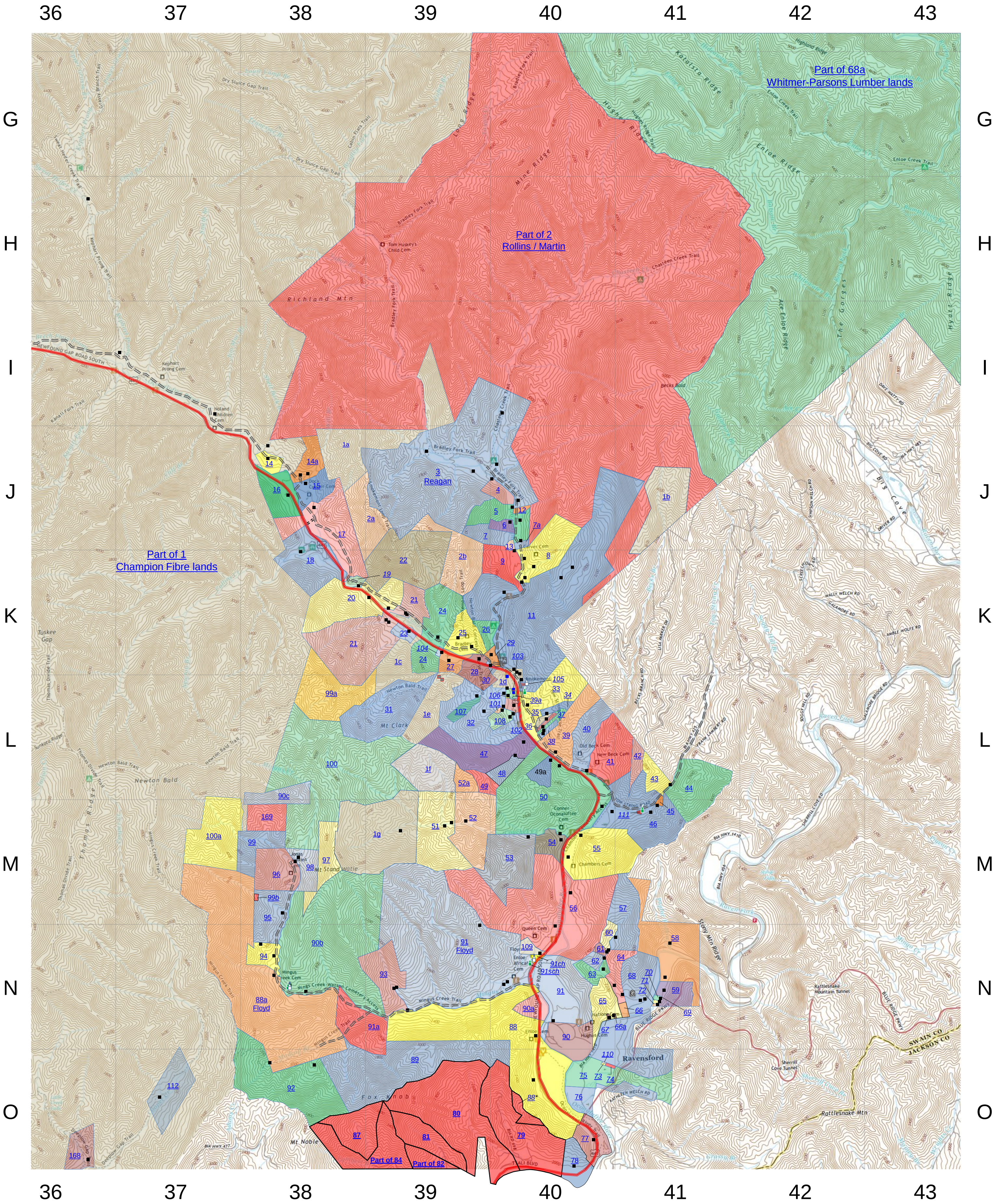

Notes

1. Dots denoting home sites are sized for viewing, and are larger than the actual homes. Each dot scales to 125 feet per side, an area of about 0.36 acres. This is larger than some of the smaller tracts.
2. The Oconaluftee tracts in red with a heavy black border at bottom center were taken by the NC Park Commission and donated to the Federal Government for the Park. The Park Service later sold those tracts to the Eastern Band of the Cherokee Indians for less than the State paid. The State of NC, which had purchased and donated the lands to the Park Service, received none of the moneys paid for the land.
