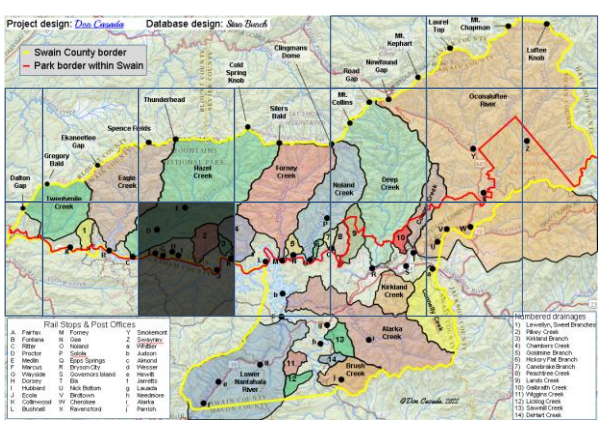


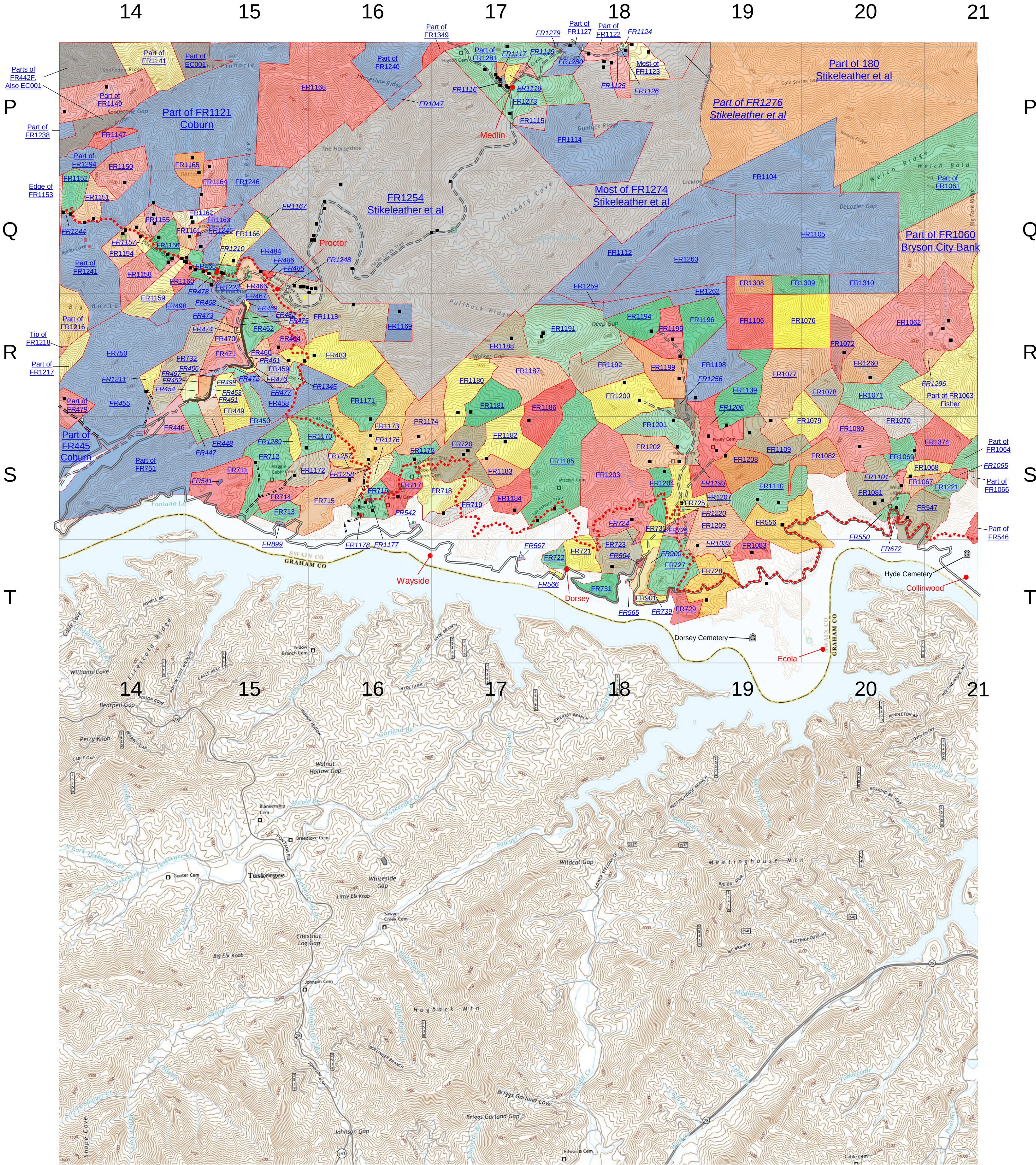

Notes

1. The dots denoting home sites are sized for viewing, and are far larger than the actual homes. Each dot is a square with 125 feet per side, meaning each dot covers an area of about 0.36 acres. This is larger than some of the smaller tracts.
2. Tracts with an "FR" prefix were taken during the Fontana Project. Tracts with only numbers were part of the original Park formation.

Scaling = 2500 ft/inch
Each grid square is 5000 ft x 5000 ft
