RESPECTIVELY

Location: These tracts are located on the waters of Oconaluftee River above Smokemont and adjoin other farm boundaries in that section. The two tracts also adjoin, and belong to father and son.

Description: They are farm tracts occupied by the owners for many years. Nice farms and well cared for. The farm land is smooth and while not level has gentle slopes, and is productive, and at the same time there is quite a portion of level land. The woodlands are in fine shape, fire has been kept out of them and while the saw timber was taken out many years ago a good stand of timber yet covers the ground.

Improvements: Nine room frame house ceiled and weather boarded, running water, in good repair, metal roof freshly painted.
