REPORT ON MRS. L. M. MANEY TRACT - NO. 16, 49.93 ACRES.

LOCATION:

This tract is located about three miles above Smokemont, near the Ocona Lufly River, at the mouth of Collins Creek.

DESCRIPTION:

A mountain farm, containing 5 acres of bottom land, 7 acres of bench land, and 10 acres pasture, all of which is very poor. The balance of the land is steep and cut-over woodland.

IMPROVEMENTS:

Improvements are very poor, and consist of a four-room house, two sheds and small log barn. There are a few apple trees on the flat land, but they are not very good.

VALUATION:

As a trade could not be made on this property, it was condemned, commissioners' award being \$1400.00, which is a fair price for the property, although we expect it to be appealed.

If the award is accepted, the appraisers ask your approval of the transaction.
