REPORT ON INDIAN CREEK BAPTIST CHURCH AND TWO CEMETARIES.

Description: These lots are unnumbered because they lie inside of other boundaries. The church building and one of the cemetaries are included in tract No. 123, known as the Columbus Kitchen Tract and contains about one-half acres. The other cemetary is included in Tract No. 117 al ready purchased from W. M. Laney and contains less than one-quarter acres.

Location: These lots are located on Indian Creek which is a tributary to Deep Creek.

Improvements: The Church building is about 30 x 40 in size, rough ceiled inside and weatherboarded on outside. The valuation of the building being \$400.00.

Valuation: We have agree to pay \$500.00 for the building and two cemetaries. No option has been taken but if your approval is given a proper deed can be secured.
